Reminder: New Edits Effective 3/16/2023

The following new edits were posted on the NYS eClaims EDI R3.1 Change Log on 9/15/2022 with six months' notice provided, in accordance with the IAIABC Claims EDI standard. These edits were implemented on 3/16/2023. FTP filers should ensure that their systems are coded accordingly to avoid rejections.

Monetary Amounts: Type = \$9.2 Data elements that are assigned the format of \$9.2 should be populated with only a valid monetary amount. Valid entries consist of eleven numeric digits with the dollar sign assumed and the decimal point between the ninth and tenth position assumed. NYS FROI/SROI-02 Transaction Processing in Claims EDI R3.1

Revised 2/9/2023

The New York State Workers' Compensation Board (Board) is transitioning to the International Association of Industrial Accident Boards and Commissions (IAIABC) Claims Electronic Data Interchange Release 3.1 (Claims EDI R3.1) standard. This document details processing changes in both the First Report of Injury (FROI) and Subsequent Report of Injury (SROI) for FROI/SROI-02 transactions.

1. Differences between EDI R3.0 to EDI R3.1

FROI/SROI-02 transactions are processed differently in the IAIABC's Claims EDI R3.1 standard compared to R3.0. The table below shows the main differences.

| EDI R3.0 | EDI R3.1 |
|--|--|
| All DNs with a Severity Code of 'F', 'fy' and 'Y' are edited (using the Severity Code of the most recently accepted Maintenance Type Code [MTC]) and accepted. | Only Implied/Usable DNs (see definition below) are edited and accepted. |
| All values on 02 transactions are assumed to be the latest value regardless of each DN's value in the most recently accepted transaction. | Only Implied/Usable DNs will be considered to have the latest value in the 02 transaction. |
| Add, Update or Delete is not specified. | Change Reason Code indicates Add (A), Update (U), R (Remove), or Delete (D). |

2. Acceptance method

IAIABC Section 4 Change 02 Claims EDI R3.1 rules as approved in IRR897 on December 11, 2019, and published in the *IAIABC Claims R3.1 Implementation Guide* on January 1, 2021, offer two methods of accepting an 02-Change transaction.

ONE: Accepting data of only those DNs that are specified in the Change Variable Segment, after applying edits.

TWO: Accepting data of all DNs that are included in the 02-Change transaction after applying appropriate edits.

New York has decided to go with option "one" above.

2a. Implied/Usable Data Element Names (DNs)

Upon further investigation, the Board determined that the edits will be applied to **Implied/Usable DN**s, which include the following:

- I. DNs that are listed in the Change Variable Segment.
- II. Variable Segment DNs that have their counter ('Number Of' DN) listed in the Change Variable Segment.
- III. All DNs with 02-Requirement Code of 'F' (Fatal), 'm' (Mandatory Match Data Element), 'mc' (Mandatory Conditional Match Data Element), 'M' (Mandatory). Editing of Implied/Usable DNs means that the Board will check for Fatal, Mandatory, and Mandatory Conditional requirements, and Population Restrictions. (Note: Population Restrictions on the counter DN ['Number Of' DN] will only be applied when the counter DN ['Number Of' DN] is in the Change Variable Segment.)


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Monitoring - Suspension Reoccurring Issues and Reminders



Monitoring - Suspension Reoccurring Issues

- Incorrect filings when awards are made to reimburse the employer. Filing a SROI-IP to show reimbursement instead of the SROI-PY.
- Receiving objections that a suspension is not due, when the employer continues wages and the claimant returns to work.



Monitoring – Suspension Reminders

When is a Suspension Due?

- When a payment of indemnity is reported - whether compensable or not.
- When a payment of indemnity has been made and the payment is later voided/stopped.

Most Frequent Errors Returned During the Past 90 Days



Population Restriction 0085-064A

This most common error for the last 90 days as well as the top error for 2022 was a carryover edit from eClaims R3.0. The population restriction is intended to prevent a new DN0085 (Benefit Type Code) from being introduced as a sweep benefit if not previously submitted as an Event Benefit or a SROI-UR(G)/SA included the Benefit Type Code. This is based on the IAIABC Claims EDI Section 4 rules. FTP filers should ensure that they systems are programmed accordingly to avoid further rejections.

Population Restriction 0016-117

The second most common error returned in the past 90 days is another eClaims R3.0 carryover. This edit supports the IAIABC Claims EDI Section 4 Match Data rules that does not allow more than one match data element to be changed at a time (with some exceptions) on a 02 transaction. FTP filers should ensure that they systems are programmed accordingly to avoid further rejections.

Population Restriction 0075-064C

The third most common error returned in the past 90 days is an eClaims R3.0 carryover to ensure that DN0075 (Agreement to Compensate Code) is sent as “With Liability” after the Board has issued a Notice that the case has been established with an ANCR/ODNCR finding in accordance with § 21-a. FTP filers should ensure that they systems are programmed accordingly to avoid further rejections.
