## CASE INDEXING CHANGES EFFECTIVE 9/26/2024

#### **CASE INDEXING CHANGES EFFECTIVE 9/26/2024**

To provide clarity and promote efficient resolution of workers' compensation claims, the Board began indexing every complete case effective 9/26/2024.

- This means that every case with an *Employee Claim (Form C-3)* or First Report of Injury (FROI) and a medical report of treatment is indexed by the Board. Following indexing, any denial of the claim must be filed with the Board within 25 days of the date of indexing or defenses listed in Workers' Compensation Law Section 25(2)(b) will be barred.
- In support of this change, relaxed Claims EDI edits were published on the eClaims change log on 7/23/2024 announcing the implementation on 9/26/2024.

#### REPORTING OF WORK SCHEDULE DATA ELEMENTS

A sender brought to our attention that changes were needed for reporting Number of Days Worked per Week (DN0064), Work Week Type Code (DN0204), and Work Days Scheduled Code (DN0205).

- To resolve this issue, we will be modifying some Population Restrictions effective 3/20/2025.
- These changes were posted on the eClaims change log on 9/16/2024 to allow Claim Administrators ample time to modify their coding to avoid rejections.

# MOST FREQUENT ERRORS RETURNED OVER PAST 90 DAYS

#### POPULATION RESTRICTION 0085-064A

The most common error over the past 90 days as well as the top error for 2022 and 2023 was a carryover edit from eClaims R3.0.

- The population restriction is intended to prevent a new Benefit Type Code (DN0085) from being introduced as a sweep benefit if not previously submitted as an Event Benefit or a SROI-UR(G)/SA included the Benefit Type Code. This is based on the IAIABC Claims EDI Section 4 rules.
- FTP filers should ensure that their systems are programmed accordingly to avoid further rejections.

#### **POPULATION RESTRICTION 0075-064C**

The second most common error returned in the past 90 days is also an eClaims R3.0 carryover to ensure that the Agreement to Compensate Code (DN0075) is sent as "With Liability" after the Board has issued a Notice that the case has been established with an ANCR/ODNCR finding in accordance with § 21-a.

FTP filers should ensure that their systems are programmed accordingly to avoid further rejections.

#### POPULATION RESTRICTION 0087-059

The third most common error returned in the past 90 days is another carryover edit from eClaims R3.0 and intended to force senders to only change the Net Weekly Amount (DN0087) on the appropriate Maintenance Type Code (MTC) in accordance with the IAIABC Claims EDI R3.1 standard.

This is a Population Restriction edit on Net Weekly Amount (DN0087) that states:

## ONBOARD – CLAIMS SENDER UPDATES FOR PARS

#### ONBOARD PAYER UPDATE

Payer workload administrators now have the ability to have a prior authorization request (PAR) moved to the correct claim administrator for the same WCB case number, eliminating the need to administratively deny the PAR.

■ The new options allow payers to request insurer review or update the claim sender of a PAR if there was a recent change in the third-party administrator (TPA).

- Two new "Actions" options are available:
  - "Request Insurer Review"
  - "Update Claim Sender"

#### ONBOARD PAYER UPDATE

#### Reminders for Update Claim Sender option

- Update Claim Sender option should always be the first choice. If the claim administrator is available to choose from, the workload administrator should be reassigning the PAR.
- Keep in mind that some TPAs may be owned by an insurance carrier/carrier group. You may need to select that sender from the dropdown to reassign it to a specific TPA.
- The Board has seen the Insurer Review option used several times when the Update Claims Sender option would have been appropriate. For now, the Board is reassigning the PAR and sending an email to educate the workload administrator regarding the proper use of Update Claims Sender vs. Insurer Review options.

#### ONBOARD PAYER UPDATE

#### Reminders for Insurer Review option

- Insurer Review option should not be used if you are going through the Controverted Claim Process. You should continue to use the Administrative Denial – FROI/SROI-04 option.
- Insurer Review option should be used if you are not the insurer on the case and it has not gone through the Controverted claims process yet or been established by the Board. Additionally, you may use Insurer Review option when the claim administrator you wish to assign it to is not an option using Update Claim Sender option.
- WCB has received Insurer Review submissions asking a PAR be moved to a different case. These requests should not be submitted as we are unable to move PARs from one WCB case to another.
